Amends Load Line Rules for Sea-Going Ships, 2013.(ND № 2-020101-073)

To implement Resolution IMO – MSC.329(90) (adopted on 24 May 2012) in the RS practice, please be informed as follows:

- In Section 3 of Appendix of Load Line Rules for Sea-Going Ships, 2013 the boundaries of Southern Winter Seasonal Zone are changed;
- On the Chart of Zones and Seasonal areas the coordinates of boundaries points of Southern Winter Seasonal Zone along the southern coasts of Africa are changed.

The Text of amendments is given in the Appendix to this circular letter.

It is necessary to do the following:

1. The above amendments to the Load Line Rules for Sea-Going Ships, 2013 shall be applied during documents consideration and ships survey.
2. Contents of this circular letter shall be brought to the notice of surveyors and interested parties in the area of the RS Branch Offices activity.

Amendments to Load Line Rules for Sea-Going Ships, 2013 (ND № 2-020101-073)

- Section 3 of Appendix

Text of item 3.1 has been replaced by the following:

"The northern boundary of the Southern Winter Seasonal Zone is:

the rhumb line from the east coast of the American continent at Cape Tres Puntas to the point latitude 34° S, longitude 50° W, thence the parallel of latitude 34° S to longitude 16° E, thence the rhumb line to the point latitude 36° S, longitude 20° E, thence the rhumb line to the point latitude 34° S, longitude 30° E, thence along the rhumb line to the point latitude 35° 30' S, longitude 118° E, and thence the rhumb line to Cape Grim on the north-west coast of Tasmania; thence along the north and east coasts of Tasmania to the southernmost point of Bruny Island, thence the rhumb line to Black Rock Point on Stewart Island, thence the rhumb line to the point latitude 47° S, longitude 170° E, thence along the rhumb line to the point latitude 33° S, longitude 170° W, and thence the parallel of latitude 33° S to the west coast of the American continent.

Seasonal periods:

WINTER: 16 April to 15 October

SUMMER: 16 October to 15 April"

- On the Chart of Zones and Seasonal areas of Appendix

The coordinates of the boundaries points of Southern Winter Seasonal Zone along the southern coasts of Africa have been replaced by the following:

- coordinates 34° S and 17° E has been replaced 34° S. and 16° E;
- coordinates 35° 10' S and 20° E has been replaced 36° S and 20° E;
- coordinates 34° S and 28° E has been replaced 34° S. and 30° E.
