

Amends Rules for the Classification and Construction of Sea-Going Ships, 2014, ND No. 2-020101-077-E

To implement IMO resolution MSC.335(90) in the Register practice, please be informed as follows:

1. IMO resolution MSC.335(90) applies to the supply vessels the keels of which are laid or which are at a similar stage of construction on or after 22 November 2012.
2. The original text of IMO resolution MSC.335(90) may be found at the RS internal website in section "Normative Documents Publication and Support Department/RS External Normative Documents, ND No. 1-0141-078-E".
3. This Circular Letter introduces the following amendments to 3.4.9, Part V "Subdivision" of the Rules for the Classification and Construction of Sea-Going Ships:

in para 3.4.9.2.1 after the words "shall be" the following text shall be added:

" $1/3L_1^{2/3}$ for ships with length $L_1 \geq 80$ m, ";

in para 3.4.9.2.2 after dimension "0,76 m," the following text shall be added:

"and $B/20$ (but not less than 0,76 m) for ships with length $L_1 \geq 80$ m;

in para 3.4.9.3 the text "of 760 mm" shall be replaced with the following:

"as specified in 3.4.9.2.2".

The said amendments shall be introduced into the Rules for the Classification and Construction of Sea-Going Ships, 2014, at their republication.

It is necessary to do the following:

1. Apply the above amendments to the Rules for the Classification and Construction of Sea-Going Ships during review and approval of technical documentation on the supply vessels.

2. Bring the content of this Circular Letter to the notice of the RS surveyors and interested parties and persons in the area of the RS Branch Offices' activity.
