Rules for the Classification and Construction of Ships Carrying Liquefied Gases in Bulk, 2012, ND No. 2-020101-068-E

We hereby inform that IMO Maritime Safety Committee (MSC), at its ninety-third session, adopted the amendments to the International Code for the Construction and Equipment of Ships Carrying Liquefied Gases in Bulk (IGC Code). The text of the valid IGC Code has been completely amended.

The requirements of a new IGC Code apply to the ships carrying liquefied gases in bulk the keels of which will be laid or which will be at the similar stage of construction on 1 July 2016 or after this date.

Full text of the IGC Code in Russian and English is posted on the RS internal website in the Section "External Documents/ND No. 1-0901-0001-R-A134 and ND No. 1-0901-0001-E-A134".

The appropriate amendments shall be introduced in the Rules for the Classification and Construction of Ships Carrying Liquefied Gases in Bulk, 2016.
