Text of CL:

We hereby inform that the Guidelines on Technical Supervision of Ships under Construction shall be amended as specified in the Appendices to the Circular Letter.

It is necessary to do the following:

1. Bring the content of the Circular Letter to the notice of the RS surveyors involved in technical supervision during construction of ships and in technical supervision during manufacture of products.
 2. Apply the provisions of the Circular Letter when performing technical supervision during installation of windlasses on ships contracted for construction on or after 01.07.2020.
 3. Apply the provisions of the Circular Letter when performing technical supervision during manufacture of windlasses requested on or after 01.07.2020.

3 EQUIPMENT, ARRANGEMENTS AND OUTFIT

Para 3.3.2.6 is replaced with the following text:

"3.3.2.6 Windlass shall be permanently marked with the following information:
nominal size of the windlass (e.g. "100/3/45" is the size designation of a windlass for 100 mm diameter chain cable of Grade 3, with a holding load of 45 % of the breaking load of the chain cable);
maximum anchorage depth, in m."
