3 DAMAGE TRIM AND STABILITY

Para 3.4.5.4.1 is replaced by the following text:

".1 oil tankers:

where the length $L_1 > 225 \text{ m} - \text{anywhere along the ship length}$;

where the length $225 \ge L_1 > 150 \text{ m}$ – anywhere in the ship length except for the engine room when this is located aft. In this case, the engine room shall be considered a separate floodable compartment;

where the length $L_1 \leq 150$ m – anywhere in the ship length between consecutive transverse bulkheads except for the engine room;".
