PART III. EQUIPMENT, ARRANGEMENTS AND OUTFIT

3 ANCHOR ARRANGEMENT

Para 3.4.12 is replaced by the following text:

"3.4.12 The wire rope shall be connected to the anchor by means of a chain cable section having a length equal to the distance between the anchor (in stowed for sea position) and the anchor machinery or 12,5 m, whichever is the less; a breaking load of the above chain section shall be not less than the breaking strength of the wire rope.

The length of the chain cable sections may be included into 1,5 times the length of wire ropes specified in 3.4.11.".
